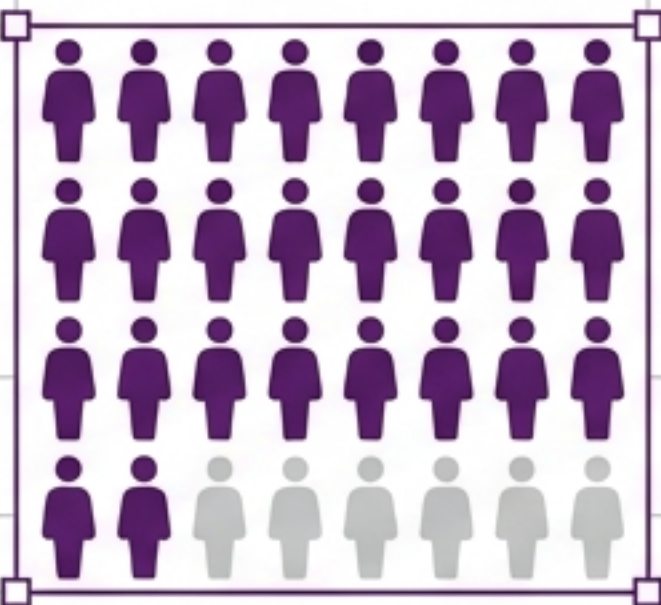

June - Dec 2026

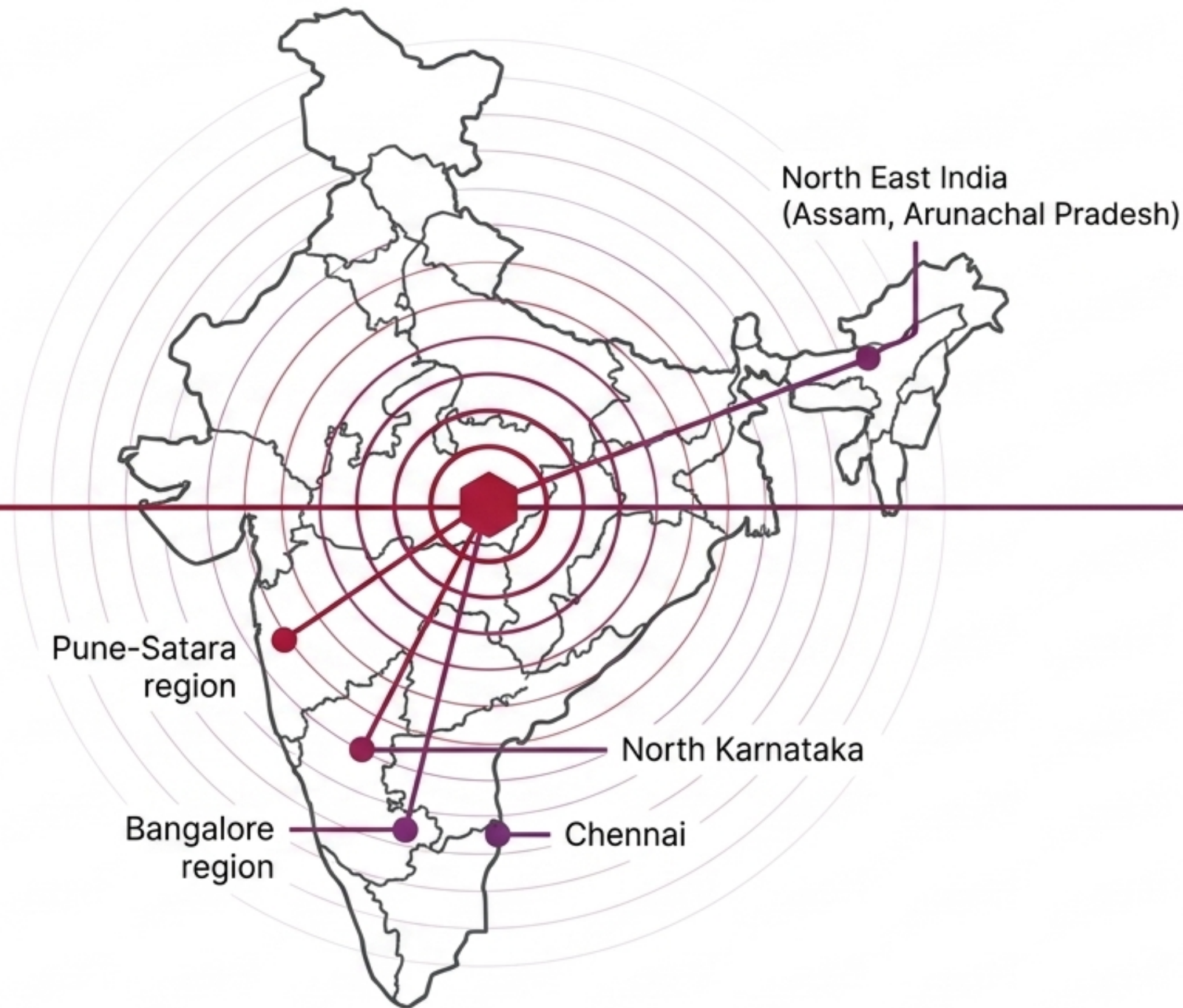
Follow up and aftercare.

Post-operative check-ups, rehabilitation support, and long-term patient monitoring to ensure sustainable outcomes.

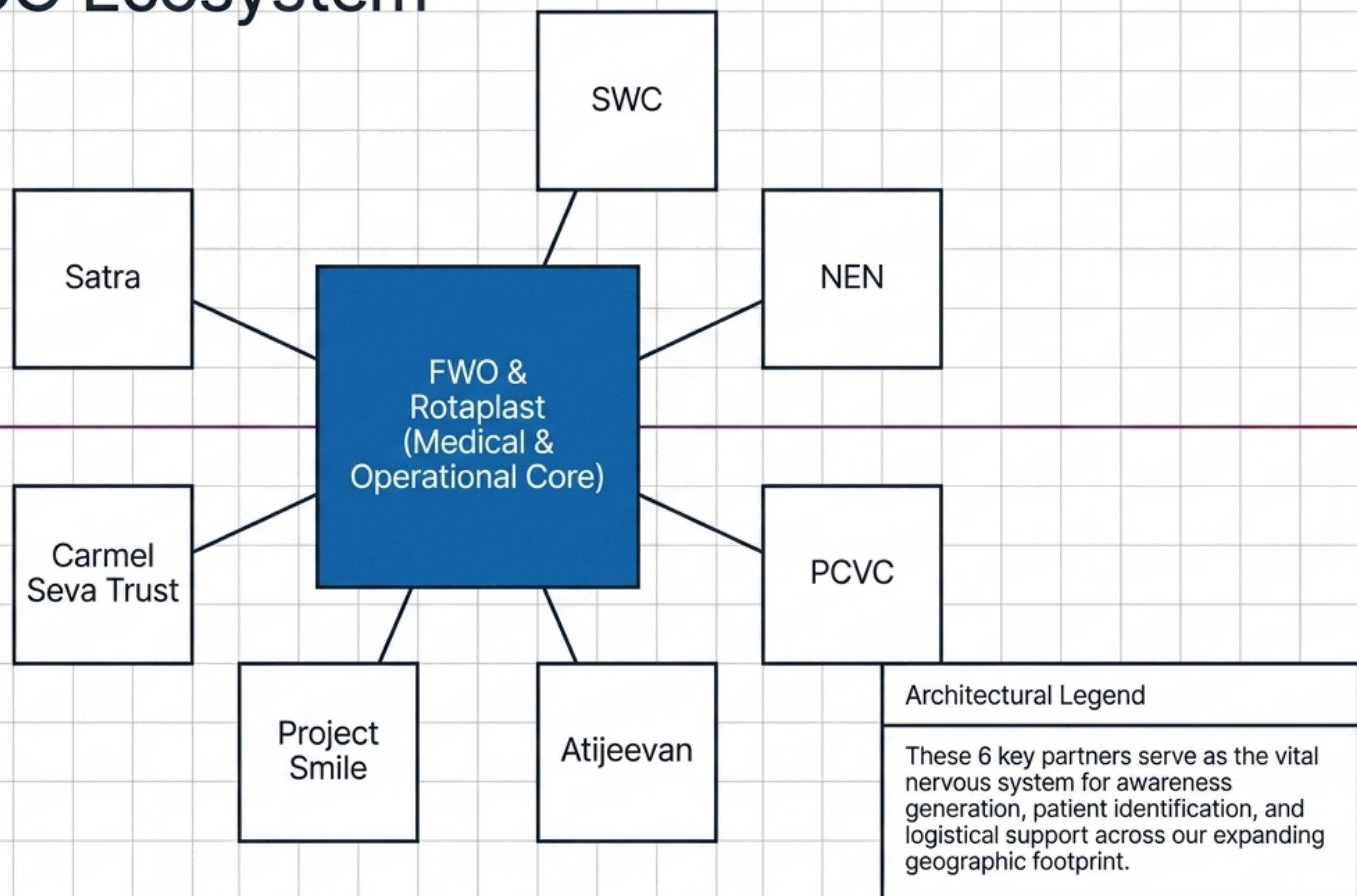

Treating severe burn contractures caused by kitchen accidents, open fires, and domestic violence.

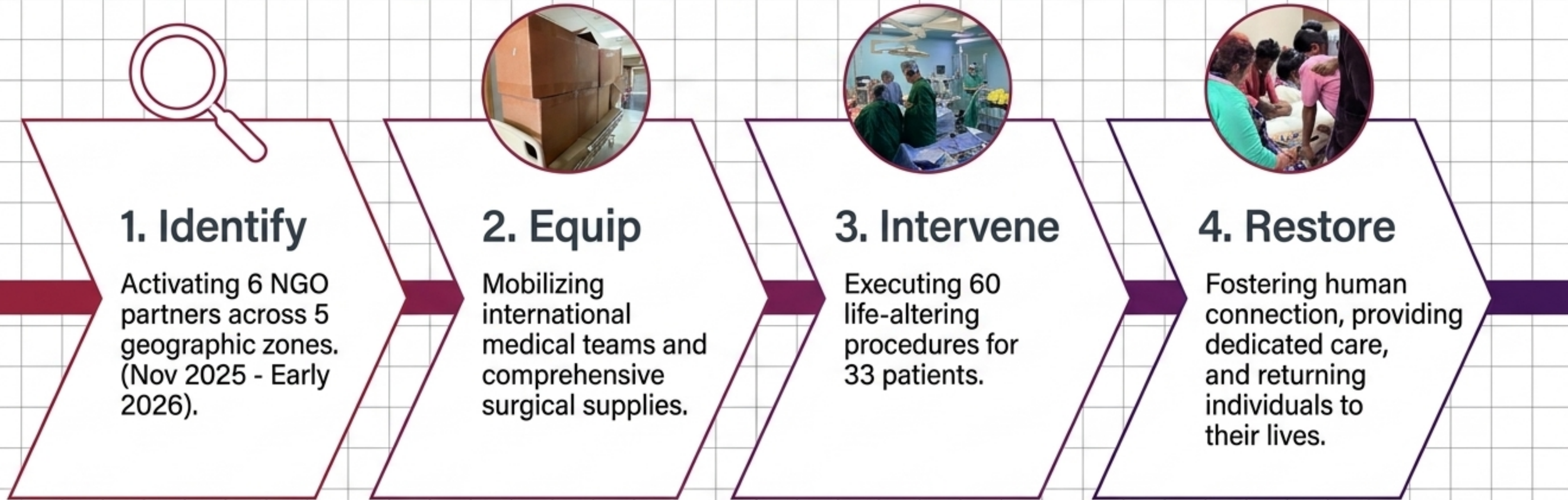
